

International Men's Day

**Whereas,** November 19 is International Men's Day, a day to celebrate men's positive contributions to their communities and families and to bring attention to social problems disproportionately impacting men; and

**Whereas**, striving toward gender equity includes concern for all gender-based disparities, including those impacting men; and

**Whereas,** according to the Ellensburg Police Department, fourteen of seventeen people who died by suicide in Ellensburg between 2015 and 2022 to date have been male; and

**Whereas,** according to national 2018 Point-in-time census, men are the majority of individuals experiencing homelessness (70 percent) followed by women (29 percent); and

**Whereas,** life expectancy for men in America is lower than women, 74.2 for men and 79.9 for women (2020); and

**Whereas,** according to Washington State Department of Employment Security, there were substantial differences in gender ratio by industry in Kittitas County (2020); male-dominated industries included transportation and warehousing (84.1 %), construction (82.2 %) and wholesale trade (71.2 %); and female-dominated industries included finance and insurance (75.4 %), health care and social assistance (75.3 %), and professional, scientific and technical services (62.8 %); and

**Whereas,** organizations and governments should continue to innovate the manner in which they design and deliver support services and resources to account for the unique needs and problems of men; and

**Whereas,** the City of Ellensburg recognizes and honors all men who contribute to the strength, vibrancy, and leadership of our City as we strive to be a place where each person can reach their full potential.

**Now, Therefore,** the City Council of the City of Ellensburg does hereby proclaim November 19, 2022 as International Men's Day in Ellensburg and encourages all community members to join in this observance.
